Crop	Target Insect	Application Method	Product Use Rate per Application	Application Instructions
Pome Fruit Apples, Crabapple, Loquat, Mayhaw, Pears, and Quince	Apple Maggot	Foliar	2 – 3 pounds per acre or 2 – 3 pounds per 100 gallons of water.	Applications should begin as soon as adult flies are active and continue until adult activity is no longer present. Applications should be made on an interval not to exceed 7 days. Grandevo should be part of an IPM program for control of apple maggot that includes rotation or tank-mix with other insecticides labeled for control of apple maggot.
GRANDEVO® has a pre-harvest interval (PHI) of 0 days . Do not enter or allow worker entry into treated areas during the restricted-entry interval (REI) of 4 hours .
