

DIBROM®8 Emulsive TO CONTROL LYGUS IN SEED

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.**

ALFALFA (Seed Only)

Lygus:

Apply 1 to 1½ pints per acre. Make no more than three applications at minimum 7-day intervals. Apply in 10 to 20 gallons if sprayed by ground equipment or in 5 gallons if sprayed by air.

All seed screenings must be disposed of in such a way that the screenings cannot be distributed or used for food or feed and records of the disposal must be kept by the seed conditioner for three years. No portion of the seed plant may be used or distributed for food or feed. All seed crops grown on a nonfood/nonfeed site or conditioned in California must bear a tag or container label that forbids the use of the seed for human consumption or animal feed. Seed grown on a nonfood/nonfeed site or conditioned in California may not be distributed for human consumption or animal feed.

DO NOT expose bees to direct DIBROM application. DIBROM may be toxic to bees up to 12 hours after treatment. To minimize bee hazard during bloom, applications should be made at night before 11 PM. DO NOT apply if weather conditions favor dew formation the night of application.
