#### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

REALM<sup>TM</sup> Q herbicide is a dispersible granule that is mixed in water and applied as a spray. The use of REALM<sup>TM</sup> Q under this Special Local Need registration is specific to aerial application(s) for burndown and residual control of certain annual grass and broadleaf weeds when applied postemergence to field corn.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Always read this label and the entire label on the product container before using this product. REALM<sup>TM</sup> Q must be used only in accordance with the directions on this label or in separately published DuPont directions.

This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

#### Field Corn - Postemergence

#### Rate

Apply REALM™ Q at 4.0 ounces per acre as a postemergence broadcast application.

#### **Timing to Crop**

Apply REALM<sup>TM</sup> Q to corn that is up to 20 inches tall. Do not apply to corn taller than 20 inches or exhibiting 7 or more leaf collars, whichever is more restrictive.

#### **Timing to Emerged Weeds**

Apply REALM<sup>TM</sup> Q when grasses and broadleaf weeds are young and actively growing. For control of emerged weeds, applications of REALM<sup>TM</sup> Q must include a crop oil concentrate or a nonionic surfactant. In addition, an ammonium nitrogen fertilizer must be used unless specifically prohibited by tank mix partner labeling.

#### **Aerial Application**

Use nozzle types and arrangements that will provide optimum spray distribution and maximum coverage at a minimum of 5 GPA. Do not apply during a temperature inversion, when winds are gusty, or when conditions favor poor coverage and/or off target spray movement.
