Fallow and Soybean Application

Authority Maxx may be applied to fallow or soybean fields to be planted in the fall to sugarcane at 5.0 to 9.6 ounces per acre. Make application of Authority Maxx at least 60 days prior to the planting of sugarcane. Apply either by air in a minimum of 5 gallons of spray per acres or by ground equipment in a minimum of 15 gallons of spray per acre.

Apply to newly prepared seedbeds as a preemergence prior to weed emergence. If weeds are present at time of application it is recommended to add a registered burndown herbicide to improve postemergence control. Observe all directions for use, precautions and restrictions on the label of the burndown herbicide.

^{*}Use higher rates for soils of pH less than 7.0 and lower rates for pH greater than 7.0 within the rate range. Do not apply to soils with pH >7.5.

Restrictions

- Do not apply less than 60 days prior to planting sugarcane.
- Do not apply more than 9.6 oz (0.396 pound active) total per twelve-month period. The twelve-month period is considered to begin upon the initial AUTHORITY MAXX herbicide application.
- Do not apply more than one application of AUTHORITY MAXX herbicide per growing season.
- Do not apply more than 0.375 lb a.i. of the sulfentrazone active total per acre per twelve-month period.
- Do not apply to soils with pH >7.5.
- Do not harvest sugarcane for 14 months after the AUTHORITY MAXX herbicide application.
- Do not apply to coarse soils classified as sand, which have less than 1% organic matter.

CROP ROTATIONAL INTERVALS

Shown below are the minimum intervals in days from the time of AUTHORITY MAXX herbicide application until AUTHORITY MAXX herbicide treated soil may be replanted. Refer to the complete label for crop rotation intervals for all other crops.
