Use Rates for Fall Application Prior to Planting Cotton or Soybeans in the Spring

(For Use Only in Arkansas, Louisiana and Mississippi)

Directions for Use

Apply Treflan* TR-10* herbicide as a preplant soil incorporated treatment. Treflan TR-10 may be applied in the fall prior to planting cotton or soybeans in the spring. For details on fall application, refer to instructions under "Application Timing" in the "General Information" section of the label for Treflan TR-10. Follow recommended soil preparation, application and incorporation procedures in the label for Treflan TR-10.

Broadcast application rates for fall application in cotton and soybean producing areas of Arkansas, Louisiana and Mississippi:

Soil Texture	Treflan TR-10 (pounds)
Coarse	10.0
Medium	10.0 - 15.0
Fine	12.5 - 20.0

Note: Use the higher rate in the rate range under conditions of abundant rainfall and mild winter temperatures.

In U.S. cotton and soybean producing areas other than Arkansas, Louisiana and Mississippi, use application rates specified in the label for Treflan TR-10 for fall application.

Restriction: In the season following this treatment, plant only those crops for which Treflan TR-10 can be applied as a preplant incorporated treatment.
