DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
- This labeling must be in the possession of the user at the time of application.
- Read the label affixed to the container of Galigan 2EC Herbicide before applying. Follow all restrictions and precautionary statements for the specific use site to which this labeling applies.

In addition to the directions for use by aerial application that appear on the Galigan 2EC Herbicide EPA registered label, the following guidelines are required between the dates of February 15 to March 31 for applications in the following geographic area:

NORTH: Fresno County Line SOUTH: Fresno County Line EAST: State Highway 99 WEST: Fresno County Line

Observe the following directions to minimize off-site movement during aerial application of Galigan 2EC Herbicide. Minimization of off-site movement is the responsibility of the grower, aerial applicator and pest control advisor.

A written recommendation MUST be submitted by or on behalf of the applicator to the Fresno County Agricultural Commissioner 24 hours prior to application. This written recommendation MUST state the proximity of surrounding crops, and that conditions of each manufacturer's applicable label(s) and this label have been satisfied.

Aerial application of Galigan 2EC Herbicide is limited to pilots who have successfully completed a Fresno County Agricultural Commissioner and California Department of Pesticide Regulation approved training program for aerial application of herbicides. All aircraft must be inspected, critiqued in flight, and certified at a Fresno County Agricultural Commissioner approved fly-in. Test and calibrate spray equipment at intervals sufficient to insure that proper rates are being applied during the commercial use season. Applicator must document such calibrations and testing. Demonstration of performance at Fresno County Agricultural Commissioner approved "fly-ins" constitutes such documentation, or other written records showing calculations and measurements of flight and spray parameters are acceptable.

Do not apply this product by air earlier than 30 minutes prior to sunrise and/or later than 30 minutes after sunset without prior permission from the Fresno County Agricultural Commissioner.
