### Reduced Rate of Clincher SF for Early Postemergence Control of 1 to 3 Leaf Grasses in 1 to 2 Leaf Rice

#### Directions for Use

Clincher SF may be applied at 10 to 13.5 fl oz per acre in tank mix combinations with labeled rates of Command (clomazone), Pendimax<sup>®</sup> 3.3 herbicide (pendimethalin), Prowl (pendimethalin), Facet (quinclorac), or Grasp<sup>®</sup> SC herbicide (penoxsulam) for early postemergence control of grasses in rice.

Grasses should be 1 to 3 leaf stage and rice should be 1 to 2 leaf stage at application. Soils should be saturated at application for satisfactory weed control. Because of the need for saturated soils at application, ground application is strongly discouraged. Reduced weed control may result from application of Clincher SF to stressed weeds. Use of an agriculturally approved crop oil concentrate or methylated seed oil at a minimum rate of 1 quart per acre must be used for all applications of Clincher SF.

When tank mixing, follow label directions, including application rates, use precautions and limitations on each respective label.
