Directions for Use

Ground Application: Apply Intrepid 2F in a minimum spray volume of 5 gallons per acre by conventional ground equipment when plants are small. Use higher carrier volumes to ensure thorough coverage as crop develops.

Aerial Application: Apply in a minimum spray volume of 5 gallons per acre in equipment that has been properly patterned and calibrated for environmental conditions at the site.

Spray Adjuvants: Select adjuvants that are recommended and registered for your specific use pattern and follow their use directions. Always add adjuvants last in the mixing process.

southwestern corn borer sugarcane borer	4 - 6 (0.06 – 0.09 lb ai/acre)	Apply at first sign of egg hatch or when infestations reach locally defined threshold levels. Reapply at 10- to 14-day intervals under conditions of heavy infestation, continuous moth flights and rapid growth.	 Do not apply more than 6 fl oz per acre per application or more than 36 fl oz per acre per season. Preharvest Interval: Do not harvest within 28 days of application. Re-Planting Interval: A 7-day replanting interval is required for residues of methoxyfenozide.

Any adverse effects resulting from the use of Intrepid 2F under this specific exemption must be immediately reported to the Louisiana Department of Agriculture.
