<b>ALFALFA GROWN FOR SEED (post-bloom)</b>	Lygus Bugs	Use ½ to 1 lb. CARZOL SP per acre. Apply when lygus bugs reach damaging numbers.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use this product only on pure stands of alfalfa to be harvested for seed.</li> <li>• Do not allow spray to drift onto adjacent crops.</li> <li>• Do not spray while bees are visiting the treatment area.</li> <li>• Do not allow livestock to graze treated fields. Do not use treated crops for livestock feed. Crop residues are not to be fed to livestock or baled for such use. Fields treated with CARZOL SP must be cleared after harvest by burning or by disking into the soil.</li> <li>• Treated seed is not to be used for sprouting. All seed treated with Carzol SP is to be tagged at processing plants <b>“NOT FOR HUMAN OR ANIMAL CONSUMPTION”</b>. It shall be the grower’s responsibility to notify the processing plants of any seed crop treated with Carzol SP.</li> <li>• CARZOL SP does not control aphids.
