Do not apply more than two sequential applications of Quadris or other Group 11 fungicides before alternation with a fungicide that is not in Group 11. Application Directions: Apply 7.0 fl oz of Quadris at early bud followed by 14.0 fl. oz. at about 45 days before harvest. A third application of 7.0 fl. oz. may be made 30 days before harvest. Applications may be made by ground, air or chemigation. Use a minimum of 10 gallons of water per acre for ground applications. |

Specific Use Restrictions: Do not apply more than 27.5 fl.oz product/A (0.45 lb. a.i./A) per season of azoxystrobin-containing products. Do not apply within 30 days of harvest.

Notes:

(1) It is extremely important to time the application of Quadris Flowable Fungicide appropriately as described above. Failure to do so may result in poor control. (2) Apply Quadris Flowable Fungicide in sufficient water volume to provide good coverage of the safflower head. (3) Syngenta does not recommend mixing this product with any other crop protection product.
