CROP	RATE PER ACRE	USE INSTRUCTIONS
Citrus	1.25 to 2.5 pounds	<p>Begin applications to protect new leaf flushes. Repeat at 14 to 21 day intervals, or more often if needed, depending on disease pressure and environmental conditions. It is important to protect all subsequent leaf flushes throughout the year. Young fruit may require an additional application.</p> <p>Under dry weather conditions and low disease pressure, use 1.25 to 2.5 pounds per acre.</p> <p>Under conditions of wet weather and high disease pressure higher rates may be required (4 to 8 pounds per acre).</p>

- The user must refer to the Federally approved Champ Dry Prill label and read and follow all directions for use, restrictions, and precautions.
- This recommendation should be in the possession of the user at the time of pesticide application.

- Do not use this product on citrus seedlings grown in greenhouses or shadehouses.
