DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DuPont™ ASSURE® II herbicide (ASSURE® II) is a selective postemergence herbicide recommended for control of annual and perennial grasses in pineapple. Applied at recommended rates and timing, ASSURE® II herbicide will control emerged grasses. Subsequent flushes of grasses require additional treatment.

HOW TO USE

Use a sprayer properly calibrated to a constant speed and rate of delivery.

Mix the proper amount of ASSURE® II in water.

- Foliar applications - Apply ASSURE® II at 15-30 fl oz of product per acre per application. A maximum of 4 applications may be made per harvest.
- Directed spot treatments for perennial grasses - Spray perennial grasses postemergence to wet (50-100 gals per acre depending on size) with 15 to 30 fl oz product per 100 gallons of water as a spot treatment. A maximum of 4 applications may be made per harvest.

WEEDS PARTIALLY CONTROLLED

USE PRECAUTIONS

- Do not apply more than 60 fl oz of ASSURE® II herbicide per acre per harvest.
- Do not harvest within 160 days of last application.
- Do not graze treated fields or harvest for forage or hay.
